Please note that equivalencies are dependent on when the courses were taken.

- Courses with a * behind them are courses that Iowa Wesleyan University requires.
- Iowa Wesleyan will accept up to 90 credit hours of coursework from Des Moines Area Community College.
- Admission to the RN-BSN program requires a cumulative GPA of 2.75 and a grade of C or higher in all Iowa Wesleyan nursing prerequisite courses.
- The recommended schedule on this course equivalency guide will support completion of the BSN degree in four years.
